



## Costs and Limitations of Certified Health IT

### Horizon Ambulatory Care

Customer must sign a contract to purchase and implement Horizon Ambulatory Care. Horizon Ambulatory Care™ requires additional fees to enable 2014 edition capabilities including:

#### General Costs

One-time training and implementation fees to enable interoperability features including:

- Direct Messaging – Supports the ability for a provider to send secure electronic transmissions of Summary of Care CDA documents to other Direct compliant providers to support care coordination and transitions. Direct Messaging also requires an OE based subscription for ongoing use of the embedded HISP that supports direct exchange.
- A patient facing portal is required to provide online access to personal health information. The portal allows patients to view, download and transmit their health information. Horizon Connect™ 2014 Edition has been integrated with Horizon Ambulatory, but other portals integrated to satisfy this requirement could have associated integration costs.
- HL7 public health reporting interfaces – Provides the ability to system generate and transmit HL7 compliant messages to public health agencies for syndromic surveillance and immunization registry reporting. Fee applies to each public health interface implemented.

#### Contractual Obligations

Change HealthCare will continue to offer support for the McKesson Quality eMeasures™ for CQM reporting period for CY2017. As this product is retired at the end of the electronic submission period for CY2017, Hospitals will be unable to use McKesson Quality eMeasures™ for any of your eCQM reporting needs for dates within the CY2018 reporting period. Customers will need to refer to your master agreements and any correspondence you have received regarding the applications and the discontinuation plans.
